



1972 - 2022

The Town of Hounsfield and the Village of Sackets Harbor were established in 1802. The community heard for years the sound of military bands and observed marching soldiers. The school and Fire Department have always been an integral part of our community.

In early Spring of 1972 the All American Day Committee was formed. The committee created a one day program with music, food, displays and speeches to celebrate the 4th of July. Board minutes relate \$325 in funding. This successful program continued in 1973 and 1974. It continued to grow and volunteers grew in experience.

In September 1974, a newly formed 1976 Bicentennial Committee presented reports to Town and Village Boards which were well received. The report contained many new programs. The 1976 Bicentennial Celebration was a tremendous success. The Can-Am Committee was formed and the annual celebration has continued since.

The Can-Am Festival has changed with the times to create a fun, free family entertainment event that has been enjoyed by thousands over the years. It is a way to celebrate the friendly relationship with our neighbor Canada. There have been large re-enactment battles performed, huge parades, live music, speedster challenges, carnival rides, food, craft, farmer's market vendors, 1812 races, kite flying, aerial art and theater performances, vintage baseball, living history performers, children's activities, tall ships, antique boat rides and awesome fireworks to name a few of the exciting activities associated with this festival over they years. When you think of Sackets Harbor, the Can-Am Festival is one of the things that comes to mind!





Suppose our history

The Village of Sackets Harbor is named after its founder, Augustus Sacket, a New York City lawyer and entrepreneur. Mr. Sacket purchased the tract of land, which became Sackets Harbor in 1801 and began immediately to encourage settlement and commerce in 1806. New settlers brought many improvements to their community. The first library was established in 1815. Sackets Harbor became a commercial ship building center. The Ontario, the first steam powered ship of the Great Lakes was built here in 1817. Schools were started as early as 1822. Sackets Harbor developed throughout the 19th century into a commercial lake port, military town and summer resort. Beautiful scenery, boating, fishing and cool summer breezes by the Lake are the reasons residents and visitors enjoy this peaceful village on the Lake Ontario.

Start out your tour with a visit to the Augustus Sacket House (The Visitor Center) which houses orientation exhibits about the history of Sackets Harbor. For more information call 315-646-2321 or *visitsacketsharbor.com*

Next on your tour is a trip to the Sackets Harbor Battlefield to explore the grounds and Navy Yard property. Follow the History trail which connects to the Village's War of 1812 Bicentennial Trail.

Today, you can visit the Sackets Harbor Battlefield to learn about the village's military history. There are restored buildings and signs detailing the War of 1812. You can even occasionally see reenactors dressed like soldiers from the 1800s. You can find out more about Sackets Harbor Battlefield on the New York Parks' website.

The Pickering-Beach Museum depicts life in Sackets Harbor in the mid 19th Century, located at the end of West Main Street, next to the Battlefield. Admission is free, donations are welcome.

End the day with a visit to Alexander Corners Veterans and Pearl Harbor Memorial which was started in 1996 with the placement of a M60A3 Main Battle Tank in a landscaped area between Rhodes Greenhouses and the General Store. In 2002 a Cobra Helicopter was added as part of the Eagle Scout project of Jonathan Rhodes, which honored Veterans and Pearl Harbor Survivors many from Chapter 7 of the Pearl Harbor Survivor's Association. The entire site where the Greenhouses, Memorial and Store are located was originally the Farm of Revolutionary War Veteran, Oliver Bates, who settled in the area in 1807. There is a history room located inside the General Store pertaining to local military activities and Veterans.



Sackets Harbor has become known for its summer festivals, waterfront concerts, car shows and this year we celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Can-Am Festival in July. Brew York Entertainment & 1812 Brewing Company provides the ultimate festival atmosphere to the dedicated craft beer, music and artisan food lover. This year, we will recognize our First Responders & Medical Personnel. A portion of the proceeds and event donations will benefit these amazing people!!

The best way to dive into a new destination is to experience the local food scene. You'll strike up a conversation with the mixologist behind the bar, seek out a spot on the waterfront patio, head to the market to pick up the perfect items for an afternoon picnic or secure a reservation at the hottest restaurant in town. You don't eat to live, you live to eat and drink the best, the unusual or the newest culinary creation. For the Foodie, traveling opens up incredible opportunities to taste test exciting dishes you don't normally get to indulge in. But right here in Sackets Harbor, you can discover the world through food without getting on a plane. Sackets Harbor is just over 300 miles from New York City, and takes about five and a half hours to drive. If you would prefer to fly, the Watertown International Airport is a quick fifteen-minute drive away!











our community

Sackets Harbor is a village situated on Lake Ontario in Northern New York. It was a naval base which withstood two Canadian attacks in battles during the War of 1812. By car, take NY 3 (Arsenal Street) west from Watertown (New York) to Adams Road or East Main Street. Sackets Harbor is about 8 mi (13 km) southwest of Watertown's airport in Dexter, NY.

By boat, Sackets Harbor should be a clear shot across Lake Ontario from Kingston.

Main Street in Sackets Harbor is a protected historic district with several independent boutiques, art galleries, museums, restaurants and bars. Parking is plentiful at either end of the village. Sackets Harbor is acknowledged as the most picturesque town in the region as historic homes sit alongside this tree-lined community.
