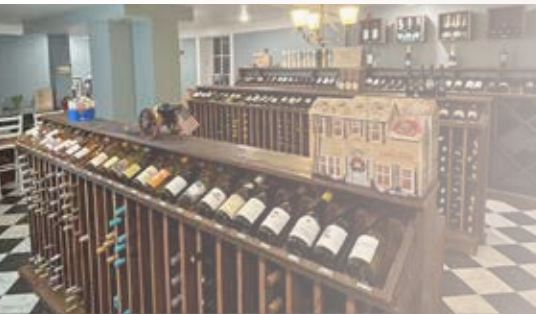

Sackets Harbor, a charming, historic community, nestled on the eastern shore of Lake Ontario, was settled in 1801 by Augustus Sacket. The village rose to prominence during the War of 1812, thanks to its strategic location.

Today, Sackets Harbor remains a vibrant lakeside community. Begin your visit at the Sackets Harbor Heritage Area Visitor Center, located in the original Augustus Sacket House overlooking the harbor. From there, be sure to tour the sites related to the War of 1812 and our military history:

- Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site
- Pickering-Beach Museum
- Madison Barracks and Fort Pike
- Military Cemetery

In addition to our historic attractions, Sackets Harbor features a range of shops, galleries, restaurants, accommodations, and family-friendly attractions. Marinas, boat launches, docks, and nearby

Westcott Beach, Southwick Beach, and Robert G. Wehle State Parks all provide a variety of outdoor and on-the-water activities.

WHERE HISTORY COMES ALIVE

Sackets Harbor played a pivotal role in our nation's history, as the site of two battles during the War of 1812

If you enjoy American History, the Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site is a can't-miss attraction! The site highlights the military heritage of Sackets Harbor from the War of 1812 through the 20th century.

Following the outbreak of war between the US and Great Britain in June 1812, Sackets Harbor became the center of American naval and military activity for the St. Lawrence Valley and Lake Ontario, with two Battles of Sackets Harbor fought here (see following page for more details).

Discover how Sackets Harbor evolved from a small wilderness settlement in 1801 into a thriving headquarters for the US Army, Navy, and Marines' northern frontier by 1812.

Explore the educational exhibits, interpretive signage, and guided and self-guided walks. Learn about Sackets

Harbor's notable shipbuilding history. Engage with site staff while visiting the restored 1850s Navy Yard and Commandant's House.

Most importantly, you'll witness how the New York State site preserves our heritage, while also recognizing and honoring all the military personnel who fought and died in the War of 1812.

The Battlefield grounds are accessible from dawn to dusk year-round; however, the buildings and exhibits are open on a seasonal basis, from May through October.

Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site

1st Battle of Sackets Harbor

On July 19, 1812, a fleet of five warships of the Canadian Provincial Marines appeared off Sackets Harbor and demanded the village surrender. With no reply, the Crown Forces opened fire.

A volunteer crew, manning a 32-pounder cannon nicknamed the "Old Sow," defended the village that would become the military's northern center on Lake Ontario during the War of 1812.

2nd Battle of Sackets Harbor

While the American fleet was away, the Crown Forces attacked on May 29, 1813 to destroy the naval shipbuilding center. After a three-hour engagement, the invaders retreated back to Kingston, in what was then Upper Canada.

For the duration of the War of 1812, both the American military and Crown Forces continued to vie for control of Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River.

INSTALLATION AT MADISON BARRACKS

Following the War of 1812, the US military presence in Sackets Harbor continued until World War II

Acclaimed as a living history museum of military architecture from post-War of 1812 through World War II, Madison Barracks played a role in every war involving our nation.

Construction began in 1816. Realizing the importance of stationed, trained troops, the US Army built Madison Barracks as one of the first planned military posts in the country.

Built at a then-substantial cost of \$85,000, the post was named for President James Madison and served as a critical link in the nation's defenses.

Throughout its existence, Madison Barracks was enlarged and improved to accommodate the military's needs, operating until World War II.

A number of well-known leaders were associated with the installation, including General Jacob Brown, President Ulysses S. Grant, NYC Mayor Fiorello LaGuardia, General Mark Clark, and General "Hap" Arnold.

Now part of the National Register of Historic Places, Madison Barracks has been reborn as a vibrant part of the Sackets Harbor community.

OLD STONE ROW & FORT PIKE

Take a stroll through the area or enjoy an athletic competition on the Parade Grounds

First built as officers' quarters, Old Stone Row still serves a residential purpose today, with families, soldiers from Fort Drum, and others living in the converted apartments and townhouses.

Just steps away is Fort Pike Park, located on a bluff overlooking the entrance to the harbor. Originally named Fort Volunteer, it was built in 1813 to defend Sackets Harbor from British attacks during the War of 1812.

Following the second Battle of Sackets Harbor, the US military expanded Fort Volunteer and renamed the fortification in honor of Brigadier General Zebulon Pike, who died leading an attack from Sackets Harbor on York (present day Toronto, Ontario).

The fort consisted of earthenworks, a stockade wall, and a variety of artillery pieces. It served as the northern anchor for a defensive ring of fortifications that eventually surrounded the village.

The earthenworks at Fort Pike are the only visible remains of these fortifications today. The Village of Sackets Harbor improved the site and converted it to a park with a trail, interpretive signage, picnic area, and observation deck.

Market Square Park is located in the heart of the village, across from the Visitor Center, where the **Sentinel Bandstand** overlooks the harbor. In 2023, the area was renovated and improved as part of a \$4.9 million project, funded by New York State and federal grants.

A Base for Athletes to Train & Compete

With an increasing number of sporting events each year, Sackets Harbor has become a destination for athletes to train and compete across a wide range of sports.

Each March, Madison Barracks hosts the Barracks Rangers Rugby Football Club's opening tournament of the year. As summer begins, Willow Running organizes the annual Summer Solstice 5k, followed soon after by the popular 18.12 Challenge, which includes 5K, 5-mile, half-marathon, and 18.12-mile distances.

Madison Barracks is also the home for two weeks each July to the 1812 Lacrosse Shootout Tournament. The month concludes with two more annual events: the Battle at the Barracks Soccer Tournament and the SpokerRide.

In the fall, the Sackets Harbor Marathon and Half Marathon draws runners to compete in a Boston Marathon-qualifying race, and the athletic season wraps up in October with the Scarecrow Scuttle 5K and Family Fun Run.

HIKE THE TRAILS

There are a number of trails in and around Sackets Harbor that offer extended hikes, relaxing bicycle rides, and everything in between.

Within the village, you'll find both the Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site's History Trail and the War of 1812 Bicentennial Trail (see opposite page for details). Additionally, the village's downtown and Madison Barracks areas are comfortably walkable and cycleable.

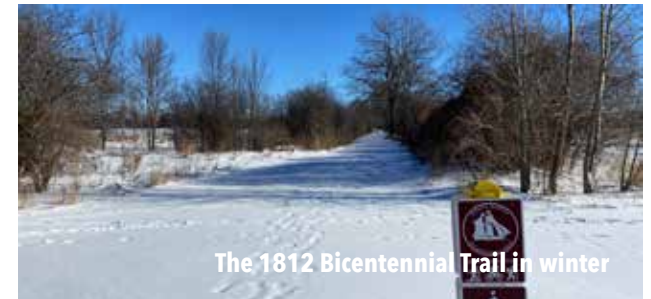
Beyond the village, outdoor enthusiasts can explore several parks & nature preserves:

- **Westcott Beach & State Park** (p. 20);
- **Robert G. Wehle State Park** (p. 20);
- **El Dorado Beach Preserve** in Henderson offers natural walking paths and tranquil lake views ([Nature.org/en-us/get-involved/how-to-help/places-we-protect/central-el-dorado-beach](https://www.nature.org/en-us/get-involved/how-to-help/places-we-protect/central-el-dorado-beach)); and
- **The Great Lakes Seaway Trail** is a nationally-designated scenic route that passes through and beyond Sackets Harbor. Offering longer road cycling loops with lakeshore and river scenery, plus quiet back roads, the Seaway Trail is popular with touring cyclists ([NSBFoundation.com/nb/great-lakes-seaway-trail-ny/](https://www.nsbfoundation.com/nb/great-lakes-seaway-trail-ny/)).

HISTORY & 1812 BICENTENNIAL TRAILS

For a short walk with a bit of education, try the **Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site's History Trail**. At just under one mile, this level, ADA-accessible trail offers a pleasant way to enjoy a sunny day while also teaching you about the village's role in the War of 1812 and the Battlefield Site's history.

You'll pass by the Lieutenant's and Commandant's Houses, the historic Navy Yard, the 1913 Centennial Monument, with historic fortifications and cannons still visible on the Battlefield today.

For a longer hike, take on some or all of the village's seven-mile plus **1812 Bicentennial Trail**. Also ADA-accessible, this trail branches off from the History Trail (just past

the far end of the Historic Site's Hill St parking lot) and encompasses more of the battlegrounds, Sackets Harbor Central School's athletic fields, the Old Stone Chapel, and the Military Cemetery.

Along the way, you'll see more monuments and historic markers, plus fields, wooded areas, and neighborhoods. You may also spot rabbits, deer, woodchucks, porcupines, and squirrels, plus a variety of birds.

Both trails are open year-round for walking, bicycling, cross-country skiing, and snowshoeing.

Westcott Beach State Park is a favorite beach, campground, and cottage rental spot, just minutes from Sackets Harbor. The park occupies more than 300 acres and features a boat launch, camp sites, picnic facilities, playground, swimming areas, scenic overlook, and trails for hiking, skiing, and snowshoeing.

Located just 15 miles from Sackets Harbor, Southwick Beach State Park is the perfect family-friendly location for a day of swimming, boating, fishing, and hiking, or a weekend camping trip. Visitors can enjoy 3,500 feet of lakefront and amazing views. In addition, Southwick features a playground, nature

center, concessions, BBQ grills, tent and RV sites. The park also offers nature trails for hiking during the summer and snowshoeing and cross-country skiing in the winter.

Sprawling Robert G. Wehle State Park is one of the newest in the New York Parks system, and it's just a 20-minute drive from Sackets Harbor.

The park boasts 1,100 acres of land, over 17,000 feet of waterfront, plus a cottage and cabin available to rent. Visitors can also access more than 10 miles of nature trails for hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing.

Wehle State Park offers tennis and pickleball courts, picnic areas, and grills. Hunting is also permitted.

TRAVELER TIP:

For anyone venturing out onto the ice in the winter, check DEC guidelines for ice thickness, dress in layers, and have a buddy, just in case.

Sackets Harbor is a water recreation playground, where you can enjoy fishing, kayaking, paddleboarding, and more. There's no better way to experience the beauty of Lake Ontario than by boat. Our marinas and improved boat launch and docks near the Bandstand make it easy to get onto the water.

Home to a variety of fish species, including lake trout, smallmouth and largemouth bass, the harbor is a choice destination for fishing. Once the open

water has turned to ice, Black River Bay and Henderson Bay are prime ice fishing sites for the winter season. Our sheltered location on the lake makes this a great area for peaceful, scenic kayak voyages. Water enthusiasts can also find opportunities along the Black River for more exhilarating adventures, including nearby river rafting.

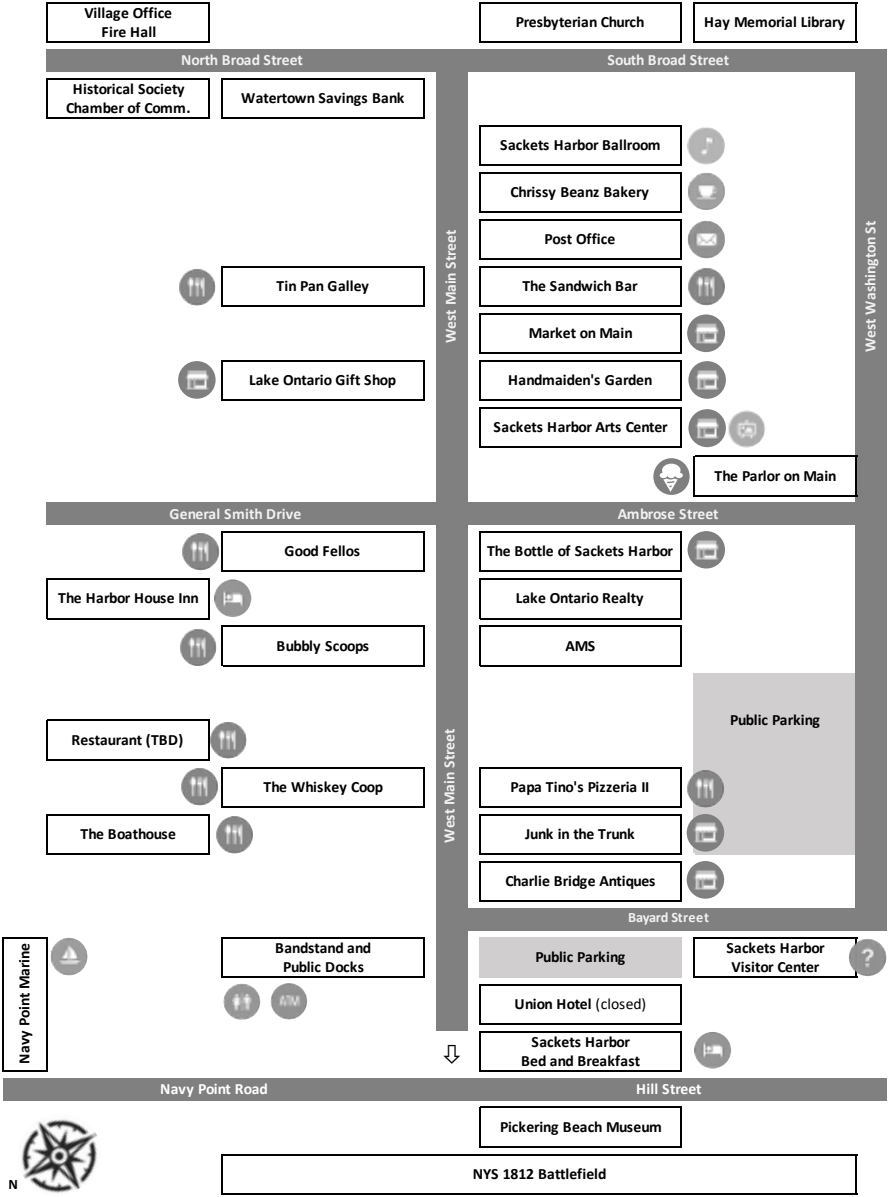

The Visitor Center

The Sackets Harbor Heritage Area Visitor Center

The best place to begin your visit is the **Sackets Harbor Heritage Area Visitor Center**. Located in the home of village founder Augustus Sacket, the house was built in 1801 in the Federal/Georgian style, and it was renovated and reopened as the Visitor Center in 1995.

Sackets Harbor was one of the original community participants in New York State's Heritage Area Program, which supports the rehabilitation of communities through historic preservation, recreation, and education.

Currently, the Visitor Center features free exhibits highlighting local history, key

sites and architectural features, and the story of the village. Additionally, you'll find travel and tourism information for Sackets Harbor and the Thousand Islands and North Country regions.

The Visitor Center is located at 301 West Main St and is open from May through October and for special events in the off-season.

HISTORIC TREASURES

The **Pickering-Beach Museum** depicts life in Sackets Harbor in the mid-1800s. It's located in a house built in 1818 by Joshua Pickering, who was a shipbuilder during and after the War of 1812.

The Museum is located at 501 West Main St, next to the Battlefield, and it's open for tours during the summer months. Admission is free, and donations are welcome.

The **Sackets Harbor Historical Society** offices are housed in the wing of an 1834 limestone building, located at 100 West Main St. One of the most distinctive and unusual buildings of its day, it was originally the Sackets Harbor Bank and is now our local branch of Watertown Savings Bank.

Nearby, the **Old Stone Chapel**, built in 1823, recently celebrated its bicentennial. It's now used for events and concerts, and it's open in the summer by appointment.

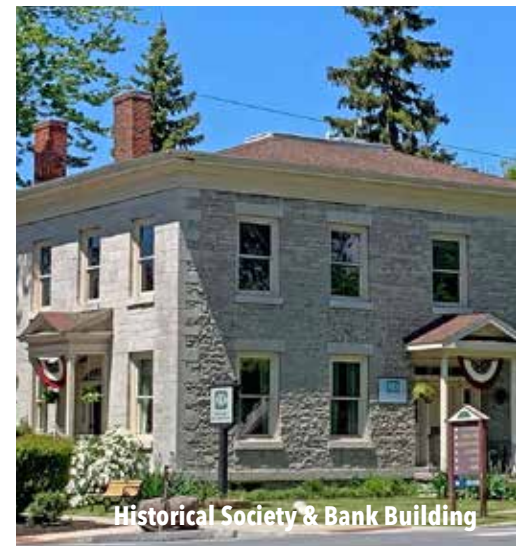

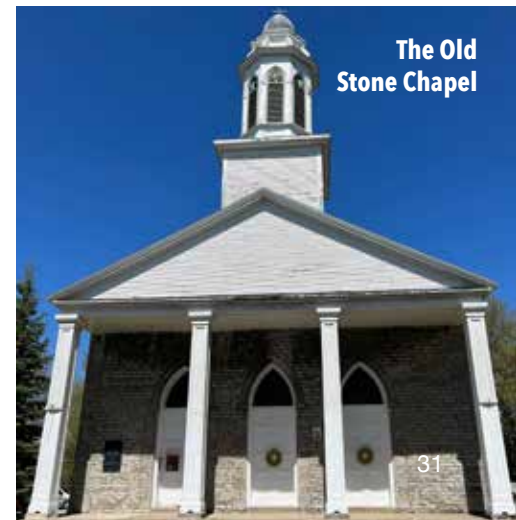

HONORING OUR VETERANS

The village recognizes the contributions of veterans at multiple sites and through our Hometown Hero banners.

The **1913 Centennial Monument** at the Battlefield stands in memory of the soldiers who served in the area during the War of 1812. Additionally, the village has monuments dedicated during the Bicentennial along Ontario Street.

Madison Barracks holds the remains of War of 1812 soldiers and memorials for veterans of other conflicts. The memorials are located near the Stone Water Tower on Brady Road and on Backus Road.

The **Military Cemetery**, off Dodge Avenue, is the final resting place of veterans from the Revolutionary War to modern-day conflicts. Most notably, it is the grave site of General Zebulon Pike, for whom Pike's Peak was named.

Lakeside Cemetery is a good destination for genealogists and history buffs. Located between Military Road and Dodge Avenue, the cemetery holds the remains of some of our earliest settlers,

including Augustus Sacket, Elisha Camp, and Samuel F. Hooker.

Within the Town of Hounsfield, **Muskalonge Cemetery's** Revolutionary War era stones, along with those at **Sulphur Springs Cemetery** and **Field Settlement Cemetery**, offer a standing record of Early American families, sailors, and soldiers.

The Alexander Corners Veterans and Pearl Harbor Memorial honors all who have served. Located on NYS Route 3 in Henderson, the Memorial was started in 1996 with the placement of a M60A3 Main Battle Tank and was expanded in 2002 with the addition of a Cobra Helicopter.

The Memorial features beautiful gardens and was originally part of the farm of Revolutionary War veteran, Oliver Bates, whose home is on the NYS and National Register of Historic Sites.

TRAVELER TIP:

As you explore Sackets Harbor, you may hear the bells of the United Presbyterian Church marking the hours or performing an impromptu summer concert.

To honor those who have served, commemorative banners are created in the winter and displayed on utility poles around Sackets Harbor and Hounsfield, in the spring and summer.

banners over the last few years," said Alex Morgia, mayor of the Village of Sackets Harbor. "We've added banners to more poles, in order to accommodate as many honorees as possible."
